The Food Bank Network of Somerset County receives no public funds and is operated by a small professional staff and group of committed volunteers. We provide free food, personal items, and household supplies to county residents in need directly from our warehouse in Bridgewater and our regular pantries in Bound Brook, Lyons, Manville, North Plainfield, and Somerville. Presently we are serving the needs of 7,000 individuals each month and that number continues to climb.

Our special initiatives include:

- The Backpack Program, providing nearly 1,000 meals per week for schoolchildren and preschoolers as young as 3 years old to take home for weekends and summer days
- Support for veterans and their families through a special pantry located at the Veterans Administration Center in Lyons
- Support for college students through the Raritan Valley Community College pantry
- Mobile outreach to public housing communities in "food deserts"
- The county's annual Adopt-A-Family Program, providing Thanksgiving meals to families in need
- Support for other independent pantries and state/county social services initiatives
- Many more in the planning stages!

Incorporated in 1982, The Food Bank Network of Somerset County, Inc., distributes food and provides other basic human needs to those less fortunate in our community in a manner recognizing and advancing selfworth and human dignity.
