Mission Statement: *“The mission of The Food Bank Network is to distribute food and to provide other basic human needs to those less fortunate in our community in a manner recognizing and advancing self-worth and human dignity.”*

Facilities & Locations:

- Main pantry and warehouse in Bridgewater (10,000 square feet)
- Satellite pantries:
 - Bound Brook
 - Somerville
 - Raritan
 - Manville
 - N. Plainfield
 - VA Lyons (for food insecure veterans)
 - Montgomery Twp.*New in 2026
- Monthly mobile distributions to low-income housing developments:
 - Branchburg
 - South Bound Brook

SERVICES WE PROVIDE:

- **General Food Assistance** thru a “client choice” pantry network - over 37,000 client visits in 2025, 32,000 client visits in 2024; up from 12,000 in 2021 and 27,000 in 2023.
- **Backpack Program** - weekend meals for preschool and elementary aged school children from low- income families - services 1,900 kids/29 schools per week.
- **SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program);** aka “food stamps”-NJ State approved SNAP Navigator as of 1/2025.
- **Wrap-Around Services** - linking clients with non-food services (housing, employment, education, health care, etc.); full time social worker on staff to manage this and SNAP Navigator program.



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Group Volunteer Opportunities at The Food Bank Network of Somerset County

Group Warehouse Activities: (5-10 volunteers)

- (Volunteers should be comfortable with lifting up to 25 pounds).
- (Most projects in the warehouse involve organization of food storage and [cleaning](#))
- (All warehouse projects include clean-up of trash collected from the day and boxes flattened)

FACTS:

- The Food Bank Network of Somerset County services over 130+ clients per day 5 days a week.
- 75-80 pounds of food leave with each client.
- The cost per pound of food is \$1.92 (\$154 per person)
- The Food Bank Network of Somerset County distributes approximately \$19,000 of food to Somerset County Residents per day.

For Backpack Program Activities: (4-6) volunteers BackPack Program Details

- The Backpack Program provides supplemental food assistance to food-insecure students on weekends.
- Eligible students from Preschool through Elementary grades receive a weekly food package.
- Packages are designed to provide weekend nutrition for children who rely on free school meals.
- Food is packed in one-gallon zip-lock bags with child-friendly, easy-to-prepare items.
- The program is free to recipients. We heavily rely on corporate volunteers to help with this assembly throughout the year.
- The Food Bank Network provides weekly packages to over 1,900 students in 29 Somerset County schools this 2025-2026 academic year.



The Backpack Program relies on financial donation to support our students with these weekly supplies. These come from grants, corporate grants/donations, or local community contributions.

Most corporate volunteer groups contribute at least \$2,500 or more toward the program wither through a grant or a donation for this weekly distribution in effort to help us cover a portion of the weekly costs to distribute the 1,900 backpacks. The estimated value of supplies for 1,900 students weekly is \$11,400 per week.
